Mr. Calvin Jones

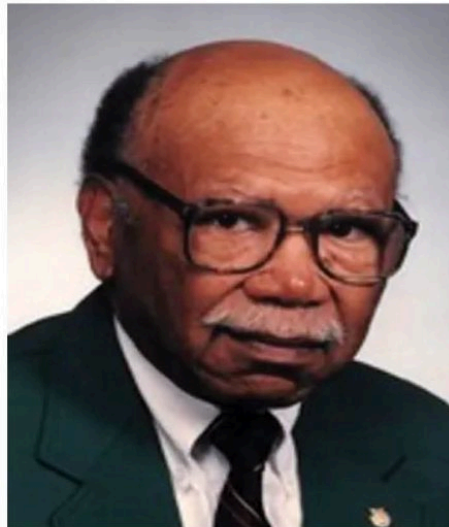
December 22, 1924 - January 2, 2024
